We are honoured that the European Deaf Badminton Championship in 2025 will be held in the Moravian metropolis, in the city of Brno in the Czech Republic.

## Basic Information

**Organisator:** SK Kuklenská Brno z.s.

**Event venue:** Tennis and Badminton Hall Sprint, Brno, Czech Republic

**Starting fee:** € 70 for singles

€ 40 for doubles per participant

An administrative fee of € 100 will apply to participants who do not stay at the official hotel registered by our organisation

**EDSO fee:** € 30 (will be sent directly by the participants)

**Type of championship:** only singles, not team

**Possibilities and price of accommodation:** hotel Vista

- €130 for a triple room per room per night
- €100 for a double room per room per night
- €75 for a single room per room per night

The hotel can accommodate all participants.

## Route from the hotel Vista to the hall Sprint

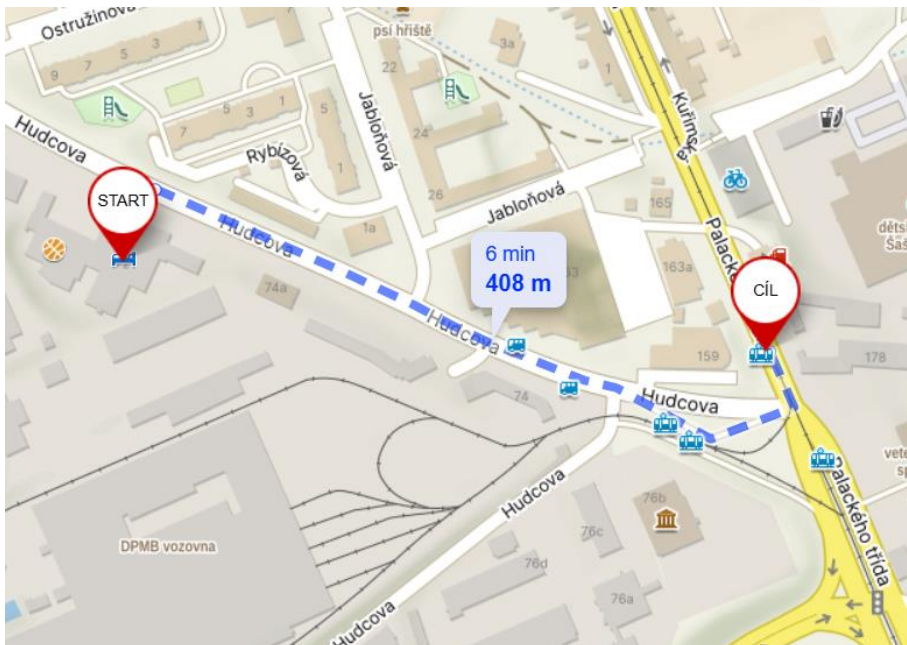
By car: 5 km, approx 10-15 min

Public transport:

From the hotel Vista, go down the hill to the tram stop Hudcova - tram no. 1 (direction Bystrc, Ečerova). Get off at the tram stop Kartouzská, then walk for 3 minutes to the tram stop Štefánikova, where you will change to bus no. 67 (direction Avion shopping park) to the bus stop Sportovní. From there, walk past the Bobycentrum hotel through the parking lot for approx. 8 minutes to the hall Sprint.

Other: Uber, Bolt

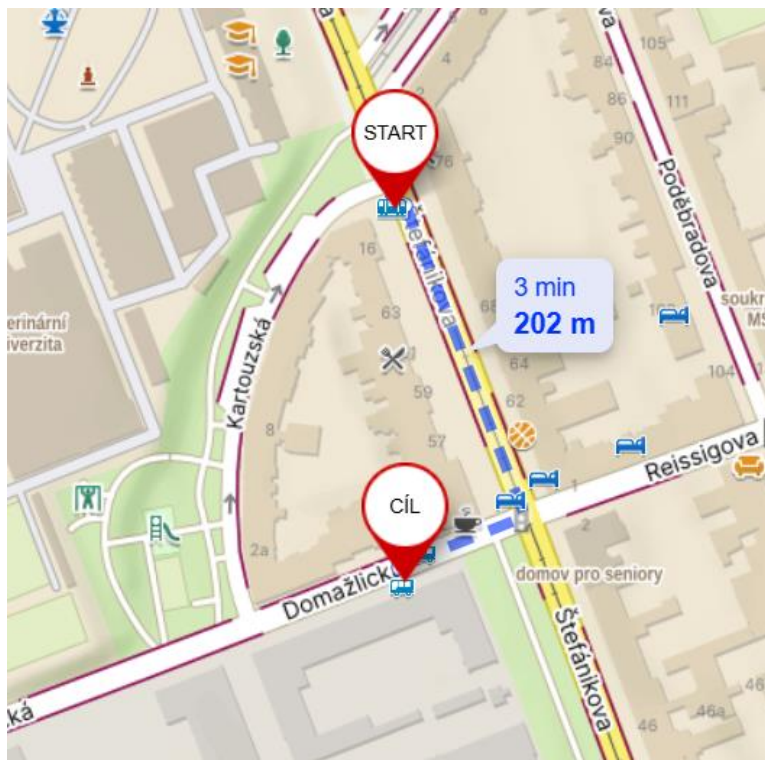
Route from hotel Vista to the tram stop Hudcova – tram no.1 (direction Bystrc, Ečerova)



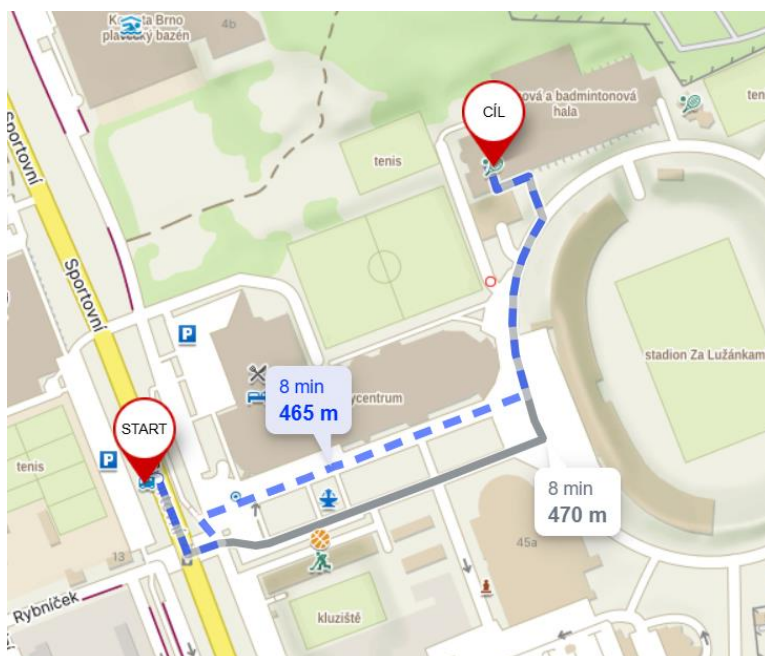
Change from tram stop Kartouzská tram no.1 to the bus stop Štefánikova bus no.67

## Transfer to Brno

You can get to the city of Brno from nearby places by car or train, from distant places then by air.

### By Car

### By train

Brno main train station.

From the main station, you can get to the hall Sprint directly by bus no. 67 (direction Jundrov), get off at the bus stop Sportovní.

### By plane

Within the Czech Republic, the nearest airport is located directly in Brno. You can also land by plane in the capital city of Prague, then also in Ostrava. From international airports, we recommend Vienna and Bratislava.

- *Brno*

Transfer from Brno Airport is provided by bus line E76 bus stop Brno Airport - Main train station. Here change to bus no. 67 (direction Jundrov), get off at the bus stop Sportovní. Another option is to use Taxi, Bolt, or Uber.

- *Prague*

You can get to Brno from the capital city of Prague by train or bus.

You can use the train carrier České dráhy or RegioJet, and the train journey takes about 2.5 hours.

By bus, the journey is approximately the same 2.5 hours, and is provided by the carriers FlixBus or RegioJet.

- *Ostrava*

Ostrava is 170 km from Brno. You can travel from Ostrava to Brno by train or bus, where the journey by train takes up to 2.5 hours with the RegioJet carrier and by bus approx. 2.5-3 hours with the FlixBus carrier.

- *Vienna*

Vienna is located 140 km from Brno and is best travelled by train or bus. You can reach Brno by train in 1.5 hours with České dráhy and RegioJet or by bus directly from the airport in 2 hours 40 minutes with RegioJet.

- *Bratislava*

Bratislava is 140 km from Brno, and you can reach Brno by train and bus in 2 hours.
